Report from the Committee on the audited project proposals 2021

a) General

Important factors in the examination of the submitted project applications were the compatibility with permaculture criteria, the feasibility and the available financial resources.

The previous members Ursula Singenberger and Ursula Rätz stepped down from office. Committee member Patrick Leu took over the task of reviewing the applications received in 2021. As the main project in 2021, the construction of the dam, was a major project directly supervised by the President, the review committee did not have to deal with it. However, it did examine the other projects submitted in 2021.

b) Projects financed

In 2021 we received the following applications for financial support:

- Feb. 2021: purchase of a maize sheller (machine to separate the seed or grain from the cobs).
- Apr. 2021: additional funds for the completion of the small house that houses the mill
- July 2021: purchase of maize for resale
- July 2021: preparation of the women's project
- Aug. 2021: additional funds for weir dam deepening excavation
- Nov. 2021: additional funds for extended payment of salaries for farm workers
